Reference: **Inquiries concerning the applicability of the SEC's Conflict Minerals Rule to our aluminum extrusion products**

To whom this may concern:

Please be advised that all of Bonnell Aluminum's aluminum extrusion products are **out-of-scope for purposes of Conflict Minerals Rule compliance**. This is because no conflict minerals (i.e., columbite-tantalite (coltan), cassiterite, gold, wolframite, or the derivatives tantalum, tin or tungsten) are necessary for the functionality or production of our products within the meaning of the Conflict Minerals Rule.

As you may know, Bonnell Aluminum is the name by which our aluminum extrusions business is known in the market place. Bonnell Aluminum consists of various subsidiary companies of Tredegar Corporation, which is a U.S. public company. Tredegar Corporation is directly subject to the Conflict Minerals Rule. Accordingly, as part of our own compliance process, we have taken the necessary steps to ascertain the conflict minerals content of our products in 2016, and the above response is based on those steps. These steps are being repeated in 2017, and based on those steps, and our current products and production processes, we currently have no reason to believe that our response would change.
